



EARLY YEARS PROGRAM REHEARSAL ASSISTANT

The position of the Early Years Rehearsal Assistant provides support to HCC Artistic Staff, and provides an opportunity for students possessing an interest and passion for music education to obtain hands-on experience with a thriving choral music education program.

Duties are as follows:

- Set up rehearsal room as requested by conductor prior to rehearsal starting, arriving at least 15 minutes prior to beginning of rehearsal (this includes chairs, piano, sight-singing or theory aids)
- Assist with dress rehearsals including staging and organization of in preparation guest/annual performances
- Assist with rehearsals by providing direct, supportive feedback and encouragement to choristers
- Track chorister and ensemble progress and submit notes to conductor, monitor levels of focus and engagement of choristers
- Other duties as assigned by the program conductor

Requirements:

- Vocal music experience
- Music literacy - familiar reading notes, rhythms, and using solfa hand signs
- Music teaching experience and/or taking post-secondary music courses
- Effective organizational skills
- Flexible & adaptable to respond to organizational needs as directed
- Vulnerable sector check
- Enjoys working with children & youth

Time Commitment: 2-3 hours per session, once or twice weekly.

Remuneration: \$17/hour
