



Title: ASL Interpreter/Artist
Positions Available: Multiple

The key role of the American Sign Language (ASL) interpreter/artist volunteer position is to provide high quality ASL interpretation/performance services during the HCC choral season and help create a more inclusive performance environment for HCC patrons requiring ASL services.

DUTIES:

- Provide quality sign language interpretation services including using forms of visual/gestural communication for HCC performances to communicate spoken words and/or choral music to patrons.
- Provide high standards of service to all patrons while adhering to HCC policies, standards, and procedures.
- Attend rehearsals/dress rehearsals just prior to performances to ensure that performance goals are met.
- Work with Conductors and Performance coordinators to ensure that performance goals are met.
- Be available to provide services for at least 1 of the primary HCC hosted annual performances (Winter performance, Spring Performance)

IDEAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- ASL Certified or close to certification
- Student OR Professional Member of an Canadian/Ontario Professional ASL association
- Background in Music/Performing Arts and music interpretation.
